

Road Education



THE 4 SCENARIOS

Each student must complete 4 scenarios: each of them has a main theme concerning the road safety. It's important for students to avoid any infractions related to the theme, to observe all the other rules of the road, and to follow the driving directions provided by the prerecorded voice.

The ranking will be determined by the number of infractions committed and the completion rate of each scenario.

Students have 3 minutes to complete each scenario, after which it will close automatically.

1. SCENARIO 01: TRAFFIC LIGHTS

There are 6 traffic lights to obey, one of which has the intermittent yellow light.

2. SCENARIO 02: SPEED LIMITS

There are many speed limit signs to obey, some of them in descending order to favor a slow deceleration.

3. SCENARIO 03: ROAD SIGNS

The road signs in this scenario are: the stop signs at intersections, the yield at the roundabout, the speed limits, and the no left turn sign at the last intersection.

Note: there are no voice prompts at this intersection, because students must see the sign and turn right.

4. SCENARIO 04: PEDESTRIANS

There are 2 pedestrians crossing on crosswalks, one at the second intersection, and the other at the last one. The first pedestrian walks, while the other runs. As they are approaching the crosswalk, a sound starts ringing, to alert drivers of their intentions; it ends when they reach the opposite side of the road.
